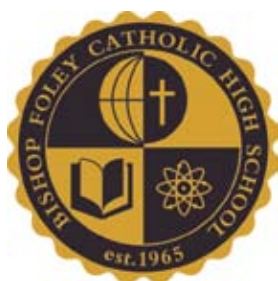

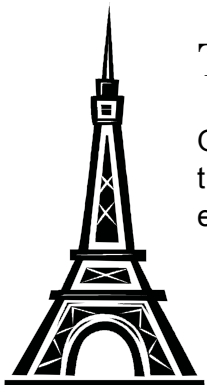

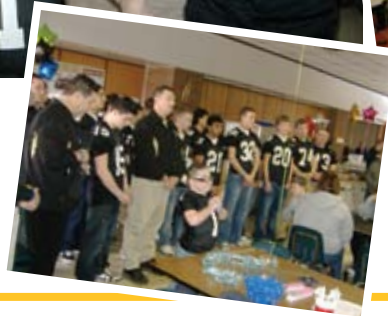


# Foley Happenings

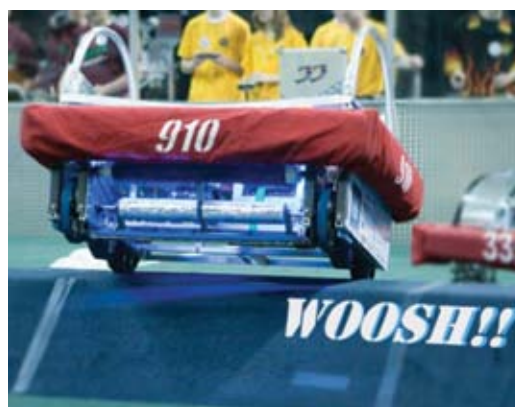
