SEASON 1, EPISODE 1:



"While much of this episode isn't found explicitly in Scripture, it gives us a plausible peek into what Jesus was doing during the beginnings of his ministry. We often forget that Jesus was a carpenter (tekton in Greek which means an artisan or builder) who earned his living through the trade he learned from St. Joseph. Also, Jesus' interactions with the children reveal his love for them and hints at the focus of his public teachings, which will come in later episodes."

RECOMMENDED WATCH: Catholicism — Recommendation by Steve Petty

This video series is produced by Word on Fire, a catholic media organization that was founded by Bishop Robert Barron. This video series on Catholicism is divided into 10 segments (about 50 minutes) that explores the basic beliefs of the Faith with an emphasis on Catholic history, spirituality and culture. The series is narrated by Bishop Barron, a renowned teacher and theologian.
