FINANCIAL AID OVERVIEW

Bishop Foley Catholic High School's scholarship and grant program supports our commitment to enroll the most talented and diverse students in the area. These discounts and financial aid grants are an outward sign of our commitment to families that are seeking a quality, faith-based education. We award need-based financial aid and tuition assistance each year. Need-based financial aid awards are grants that do not need to be repaid.

Students are encouraged to apply for all scholarships and grants (respectively) for which they feel they may qualify. When determining financial need, Bishop Foley Catholic considers the number of children in Catholic school, college, special family situations, etc. If your financial situation changes significantly throughout the year, please contact the Business Office explaining your circumstances. Sometimes, additional grant money becomes available after the school year begins.

OTHER FORMS OF TUITION ASSISTANCE

Parish Subsidies, Grants and Awards

Many of the parishes in the Archdiocese of Detroit have programs to assist students who attend Catholic Schools. It is always advisable to check with your parish for requirements.

» Scrip

Scrip is a program that enables you to earn money for tuition by pre-purchasing gift certificates to any of the over 200 stores, restaurants, movie theaters or gas stations in the area that participate. A list of companies that participate is listed on the forms available in the Main Office. Each of the contributing companies offers a rebate — a particular percent of the amount purchased to be returned to Bishop Foley Catholic to apply toward your student's tuition. Extended families and neighbors can also place orders in your student's name. Some families receive between \$300 and \$500, and others receive over \$1,000 per year.

» Bishop Foley Catholic Tuition Discounts

Multiple Child Discount — To qualify for the Multiple Child Discount, all of the children must be attending Bishop Foley Catholic concurrently. The discount is applied to the oldest child's account. For the second child, the discount applied is \$1,000. For the third child, the discount applied is \$2,000. Recipients of the Multiple Child Discount cannot qualify for the Alumni Discount as well.

Alumni Discount — This discount of \$500 is applied to one child's account. Families are only eligible if one or both parents attended BFC; it does not apply to older siblings or other relatives.

Application Process:	Students must apply to BFC by the priority application deadline and are
	chosen based on their HSPT results. No other application forms are required.
Award Amount:	\$500 (non-renewable)

Who Qualifies:	Incoming freshmen

Application Process:	Drama, dance, instrumental and/or vocal students will present a two-to-three
	minute audition for the Performing Arts program coordinators. Applicants
	must provide their own music and/or drama selection.
Award Amount:	\$1,000 freshman year • \$500 renewable each subsequent year
Renewal Requirements:	Students must be involved in the performing arts club relevant to the talent
	they auditioned with and participate in all productions for that club. Students
	are also required to take at least one performing arts elective a year.

Renewal Requirements:	Students are required to take at least one foundational/intro-level visual art
	course, one intermediate visual art course, Digital Design and AP Studio Art
	during their four years at BFC; they must also be actively involved in Art Club,
	participate in one art-related community service project (approved by the art
	teacher) and submit work to the Scholastic Art & Writing Awards each year.

Application Process:	Students must be formally accepted to Bishop Foley Catholic and write an essay of 250 words or more describing how having an alumni relative has shaped their decision to come to Foley, what qualities in their relative(s) they admire and why, how this scholarship would help their family financially, and why they would like to attend BFC and honor their family's legacy. Applicants should submit their essay via email to scholarships@bishopfoley.org by the application deadline.

SUPPLEMENTAL SCHOLARSHIP DOCUMENTS

» File Types

If you are applying for a scholarship that requires an essay or letter of recommendation, those documents **must** be submitted as a PDF file. **Word and Google Docs will not be accepted,** but both applications allow users to save work as a PDF. Submissions that do not meet the file type requirements will not be considered.

» File Names

Likewise, any document being submitted for a scholarship application should be titled appropriately. Your student's first and last name, as well as the scholarship they are applying for, must be included in the file name when you submit it. For example:

Smith, John – Leadership Scholarship Application.pdf

ARCHDIOCESE OF DETROIT (AOD) TUITION GRANTS		
Who Qualifies:	Accepted Bishop Foley Catholic students in grades 9–12 who are Catholic and are a registered member of a parish. A limited number of grants are available to non-Catholic families. Grants are allocated based on financial need and family circumstances.	
Application Deadline:	February 28, 2025	
Application Process:	Complete and submit the online FACTS Financial Aid application, which can be accessed at www.bishopfoley.org/affording-bfc . <i>Please note:</i> Only one FACTS Financial Aid application is needed to apply for both the BFC and AOD tuition grants. All applicants must be a registered parishioner of an AOD parish and request a signature from their pastor. More information is available at www.detroitcatholicschools.org/tuition-assistance-scholarships .	
Maximum Amount:	Decisions are based on a family's income level, family size, number of students in Catholic schools, monthly expenses and special circumstances or hardships. The total amount of tuition assistance provided each year is based on the availability of funds and the number of applicants.
